

FAIRFIELD-SUISUN ADULT SCHOOL CHILDCARE

(FSASCC)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Please send a small snack, and a non-sugary drink. **Please, no big backpacks!**

Children need to be ready for the day at drop off. (clean diaper on and send extra diapers/clothes/bottles in Ziplock bag with name printed on it)

If your child is 3 years old or over 30 pounds and is in diapers or pull ups and they have a bowel movement you will be paged to change them.

If your child is 3 years old and has been introduced to potty training they are eligible for our Preschool Program.

Please let the provider know if your child (ren) has dietary restrictions and/or allergies.

The Child Care Center will follow the same holidays/days off that are observed by the Fairfield-Suisun Adult School. Please see the posted calendar for details. A change of clothing **must** be provided for each child at the Child Care Center. In a large Ziplock bag with the child's name written on it and replaced when soiled.

Children ages 18 months-5 will be accepted for daytime program, ages 18 months-11 years nighttime program.

SICKNESS POLICY:

The FSASCC is a "well-child care facility". The following illness policies will be strictly enforced, for the health, well being and safety of all concerned.

Fever: A child needs to be fever free for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to childcare, that means the child is fever free without the aid of Tylenol®, or any other fever reducing substance.

Fever AND/OR sore throat, rash, vomiting, diarrhea, earache, irritability, or confusion.

Diarrhea: runny, watery, bloody stools, or 2 or more loose stools within the last 4 hours.

Vomiting: 2 or more times in a 24 hour period. Note: please do not bring your child if they have vomited in the night.

Breathing trouble, sore throat, swollen glands, loss of voice, hacking or continuous coughing.

Runny nose (other than clear), draining eyes or ears.

Frequent scratching of the body or scalp, lice, rash, or any other spots that resemble childhood diseases, including ringworm.
