Childcare Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Who is eligible to register for the Adult School Childcare?

A. Children enrolled in the Adult Education Childcare program must have a parent and/or guardian actively enrolled in one of the following Programs:

- GED Parent Education
- ELA High School Diploma
- CNA CTE

Q. What are the times for childcare and where?

A. Monday-Friday, 8:30 AM-3:30 PM and Monday-Thursday, 5:15 PM-8:45 PM (closed between 3:45-5:15) Drop off and pick up are in room 18

Q. What are the ages for Childcare?

A. Daytime-1 year to 5 years Nighttime-1 year to 10 years

Q. How do I register?

A. Go to the Registration office, pay \$20 materials fee. You can view and print the policy and procedures at Solano-spaceprogram.com, the emergency card needs to be filled out and returned the first day of care to the staff in childcare. Immunizations must be up to date and a copy brought in for our file. You cannot leave your child without returning the blue emergency card and immunizations proof.

Q. What are reasons a child would be dismissed from childcare?

A. At any time the contract between the parent/guardian or childcare could be terminated for failure to comply with rules. Failure to stay on campus or in class and failure to attend three (3) consecutive days without notice or three (3) tardies could be grounds for dismissal.

Q. Do we provide drop-in care?

A. No, we only have so many spaces and a waiting list., No older siblings are allowed when they have days off school.

Q. Who can drop off and pick up your child?

A. The student MUST be in class while child is in childcare, if someone else will be dropping off later or picking up sooner, staff must to be notified. Failure to notify could be considered an absence.

Q. What if I decide to no longer attend?

A. Please notify the office, we have other families that are on a waiting list.

Q. What happens if my child is ill?

A. Please keep them home if fever is at or over 100 degrees or have any vomiting or diarrhea. If they become ill while in care you will be called to pick them up immediately.

Q. What is the staff to student ratio?

A. One staff member per 5 children

Q. What are the staff's qualifications?

A. CPR and First Aid certified, required immunizations, ongoing monitoring by teachers
